Primal Class:

- Protected animals in the National Park O.Ö. Kalkalpen (Att. 1)
- CITES –registered animal species existing within the area of the European Union. Annex AI (Att. 2)

Common Class:

- Free design of wild and domestic animals

Manufacturing Method

- The main material must be metal
- Any manufacturing technique is accepted
- High quality and attractive design is wanted
- The works of art must be suitable for being exposed outdoor and equipped with a solid fundament, able to resist a wind force of 60 km/h. Small art works (smaller than 40cm length of edge) will be exposed in the museum "Forum Hall"

- The municipality of BAD HALL reserves the right to reject applied works of art without giving reasons.

Delivery

- The delivery and installation of the accepted works of art is possible from Wednesday, 21st April 2010 until Friday, 23rd April 2010, between 8.00 Uhr to 17.00 o'clock.
